 MARCIA W. DORT STRING SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION**

When: Wednesday, January 27, 2010 6:00 – 9:00 PM

Eligibility: Any exceptionally talented violin, viola, cello or bass player who is a member of the Flint Youth String Orchestra, Flint Youth Philharmonia or Flint Youth Symphony and who will not have graduated from high school by May 31, 2010 may audition.

Audition

- Requirements:**
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - Two (2) solos of contrasting style, one memorized *
 - Piano accompaniment is required for the audition
 - Interview
- * The performance portion of the audition will not exceed 10 minutes. The adjudicator may cut off your pieces if the length totals more than 10 minutes.
 ** Note, the fall recipient of the Marcia W. Dort scholarship is not eligible to audition for the winter scholarship.

Scholarship: To be used for sheet music, strings, case, bow, recordings, and additional private lessons. The scholarship may not be used for summer camp study. (Effective January 28 to May 31, 2010.)

The recipient and parent will submit a draft proposal to the FSPA director, who will present it to the trustees for approval. In addition, the scholarship recipient must perform a solo recital prior to May 31, 2010.
